

Clinical Attachment Policy

A clinical attachment is a period of time when a practitioner is attached to a clinical unit, with a named supervisor, with the broad aims of gaining an appreciation of the nature of clinical practice in Qatar and of observing the role of practitioners.

To be recognized for registration purposes, all clinical attachments must be done with proper supervision and must end with a report by the supervisor, a record of the number of hours worked, and a log of activities relevant to the scope of practice.¹
