

Supervision Policy¹

Supervision means the monitoring of, and reporting on, the performance of a health practitioner by a superior with an appropriate scope of practice. The supervision requirements for each scope of practice are included in the section of the manual entitled "scopes of practice and registration requirements."

The following scopes of practice do not require supervision:
